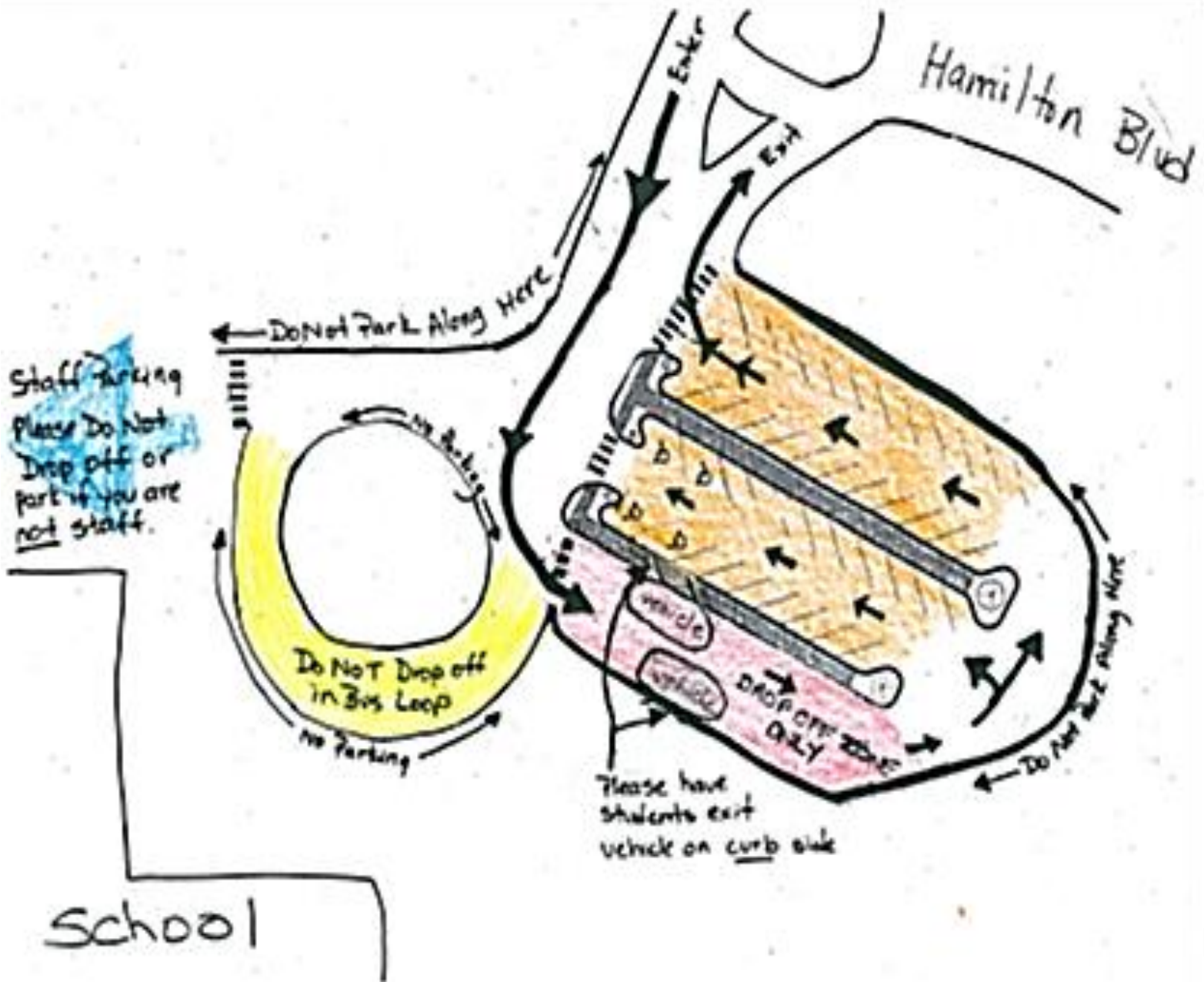
Cabane a Sucre was held at the school last week and the students enjoyed participating in this French Cultural event!
