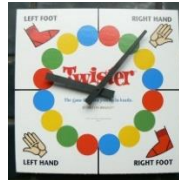
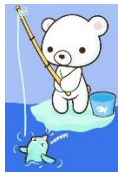

Canned food

- Pasta (375, 500, 900 g or large)
- Mac and Cheese
- Rice
- Peanut Butter
- Cereal, hot or cold (large)
- Granola Bars
- Soda crackers
- Sugar, flour

Beverages

- Juice (1 or 2 L)
- Coffee (ground), not flavored
- Tea (herbal, regular)

Other items

- Feminine hygiene products (pads, tampons)
- Toilet paper
- Diapers (all sizes)
- Depends (medium-large)
- Soap, toothpaste, tooth brushes, razors, shampoo

Things we can't use:

- Homemade foods
- Opened Items
- Home pickled/canned goods
