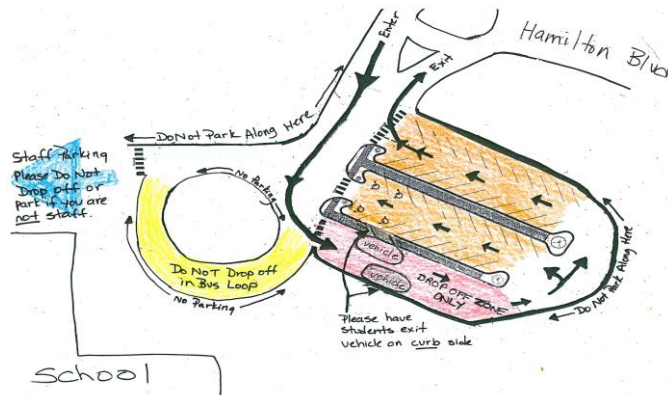

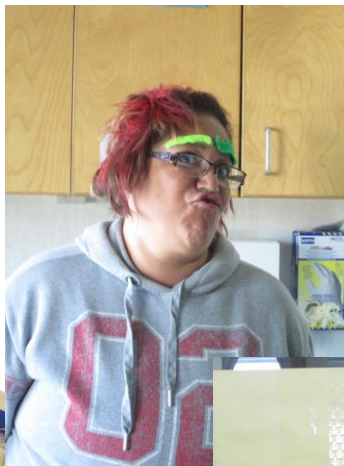


We are Participating in the FTGU (From The Ground Up) fundraiser again this Year. Order Forms were sent home with your child on Monday Sept. 11th.
