

Instructions:

Dännch'ea dunèna and families! This activity will have you create a pocket sized flipbook of Nèna Ghra – Baby Animals that are born in Ädałäl – Spring. This activity will only use one piece of paper and I will explain the folding and cutting instructions on how to create the pages. I am also in the process of creating a website that will allow me to share audio along with my lessons, share various resources and PDF documents. This website is a work in progress, please be patient and understanding. The audio will be available on the Monday that the assignment is sent out.

Folding the paper to create a flipbook:

First fold the paper into a hotdog. Then fold the hot dog in half and again in half. Open the page and you should have 8 boxes all together and each nèna ghra – baby animal should be in each rectangle. Now, fold the paper hamburger style and you will see a black line in the middle of the page. Cut the line with scissors, only to the end of the line. Now, fold the paper once more into a hotdog, and push the cut part open to create a diamond shape in the middle. Put the 2 ends you are holding together and you will make pages that you can adjust to have the title page in the front and name in the back. If you have trouble I have attached a link to a video showing you how 😊
